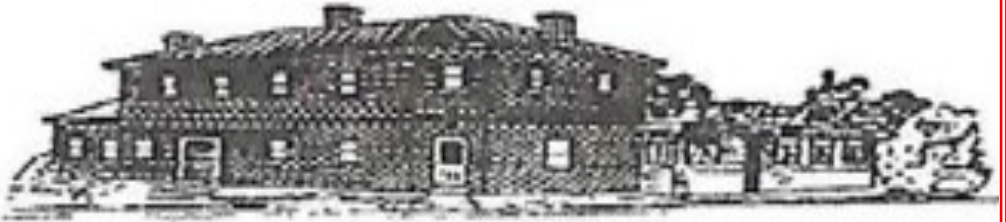

## SENIOR FOOTBALL COACH - CAMERON PENNY

### Round 6 Penshurst 14.11.95 to WLB 9.14.68

This was another big challenge, it was pleasing to see us grind it out as the game went on, it speaks to our collective determination and belief we have in each other. We started the game excellently, I believe this was our best first quarter all season, we were efficient with ball in hand and applied the focal points of the game straight away, strong tackling and one touch footy. The 2nd quarter saw W/LB respond without really eroding our lead but the real challenge came in the third, W/LB began to break free from stoppage, rebound freely from defence and generate higher percentage forward 50 entries. Pleasingly we responded again in the last, reverting back to our style of footy, this kept them at arms length and saw us record another important win.

### Round 7 vs Great Western 6.9.45 to Penshurst 11.14.80

Any long away trip in wet, cold and blustery conditions requires the right mindset to get the job done. Great Western started the game well, they showed a willingness to be first to the footy & took their opportunities. We started to warm into the contest after 1/4 time, it was pleasing to see good connection in our forward line during this quarter, both from the kicks coming in as well as the structure (where we were positioned) and the leading patterns of the forwards. After halftime we continued to grind away, another big positive was the dour and disciplined effort of our backline, we repelled attacks but also as the game went on we exploited Great Westerns hesitancy to chase with some excellent counter attacks out of our backline. Although it is a smaller oval, we got better connection when our half forward line staggered up the ground a bit more to provide some more options coming out of our defence. Wins like these are a credit to the group, these days require hard work and commitment and when we were challenged we once again responded. 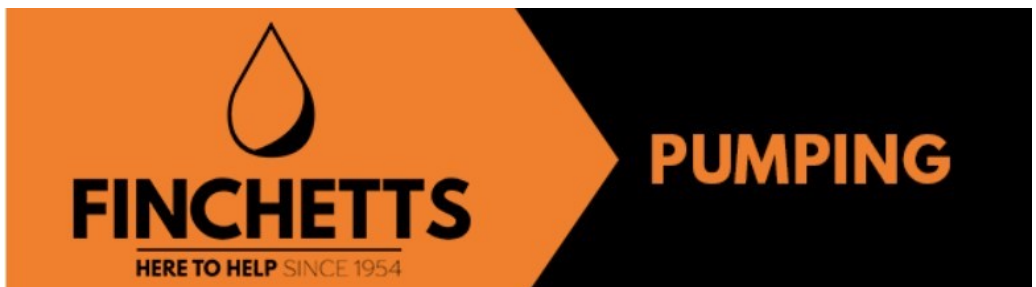

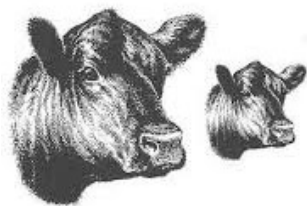

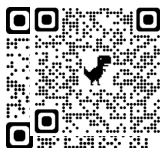
